

Operating and maintenance instructions poultry pliers ZG3

Handling and applying the forceps

Warning: Killing without prior stunning is not permitted!!! This is done by using the SG device. You can find more information about the product on the homepage.

Grasp the device with both hands at the rear end of the handles.

The arrangement of the thighs at the front is irrelevant.

Important: Position the pliers directly below the head as shown in Figure.

Coming from behind, the pliers must be applied high up. If the pliers are applied to the side or too deep, the air is squeezed out of the animal, but the neck is not broken!!

Squeeze the pliers with all your strength. The cervical spine should now be severed. Check with your hand whether the cervical vertebra has been severed. Only skin should be felt in the affected area.

Care and Maintenance

Clean the device after each use.

To correct any play that may arise in the pivot point, loosen the nut (POS.1). Adjust with the inner nut (POS.2) until the desired Mobility is almost established.

Tighten the outer nut (POS.1) again.

Note: By tightening the outer nut, the play is reduced again and the mechanism may be jammed. Leave some slack accordingly when tightening the inner nut over.


The use of lubricant can be dispensed with.
